

WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHY 2010

The absolute cornerstone of our approach to Wedding Photography is that we never forget whose day it is.....YOURS.

We promise and guarantee that we will photograph your wedding with good humour, enthusiasm and with a good attitude. We aim to ensure that the photo sessions on your day are as enjoyable and as stress free as possible.

The way we achieve this is by spending time with you before the wedding day. We meet every couple at least 2 to 3 times before the wedding, at the initial booking stage, at the pre-wedding shoot (see next page) and about 7 to 10 days before the wedding, when we go over your final details.

WHAT WE PHOTOGRAPH?

Our aim is to take a wide variety of photographs on the day, from photographs of you together and individually, with parents and families, casual shots as you mingle with your guests, and detail shots (e.g. flowers, shoes, orders of service etc). Any of your photographs can be in colour, black & white, sepia or black & white with colour details.

Your photography will usually start at the bride's house before the wedding, onto the ceremony and reception, normally finishing when you start your receiving line.

BOOKING.

The first stage is to make an appointment to meet us. We put at least an hour aside for your visit and prefer it if both of you can come along. Parents are also most welcome.

During this meeting you will be able to look through 4 or 5 complete wedding albums. (Please note that each album contains one wedding only. We do not show albums full of our "Greatest Hits", as we want to give you an honest idea at what we do on a day to day basis).

Today, there are many different styles of Wedding Photography available, and it is vital that the way we work, is the style you are looking for, and, also that you feel comfortable with your photographer.

After you have been to see us you may want to book straight away, or you might be visiting a number of photographers. If it is the latter we will be happy to hold the date for about 7 days.

PRE-WEDDING SHOOT.

We believe this is the single most important addition to our wedding services, **ever.**

The Pre-Wedding Shoot will usually be done within 4 to 6 weeks of booking your photography with us.

The main object of this shoot is to let you get used to being photographed before your wedding day, to let you see how we go about our work and mostly to let us get to know each other before the wedding.

SERVICES.

1/. Standard Albums. These are aimed at couples who are having a small wedding or who want a traditional approach to their photography. We aim to give you a minimum of 60 to 80 photographs to choose from. Your album will include your first 35 photographs.

2/. Storybook Albums. On the coverage's below we will take as many photographs as time allows. With these coverage's your album will contain photographs in a mixture of different sizes (mainly 5"x4" and 10"x8").

A booking fee of £150 is required to secure the date.
